Requirements for Main Piece

Requirements for Flap

Plain Black/Navy Cotton 42 x 42ins

Black or Navy Cotton 14 x 13ins

Wadding 42 x 42 ins

Wadding 14 x 13 ins

Fun children's cotton 42 x 42ins (these could be pieced) Fun children's fabric 14 x 13ins

Straight strip of cotton approx 3 x 180 ins - to go ALL round the quilt, can be any colour or pieced

Velcro (NOT self adhesive) 9 ins & Black Bias binding 36 ins (in pack)+ template for 'hole'


Instructions for main piece

1. Layer the main pieces - black (R side down), wadding, fun fabric (R side up)

2. Pin the layers together firmly.

3. Quilt lines across the main quilt, using black thread on the black fabric, in both directions, forming a grid, about 5ins part

4. Place the template in the MIDDLE of one side of the quilt, mark & cut out,



5. Bind the 'hole' with the Black bias binding provided. Raw edge

6. Cut the Velcro into 5, place & sew the SOFT Velcro pieces, either side of the middle of the 'hole' & either side, & centre of the top of the 'hole' of the top

7. Make the Flap:


Layer the backing, wadding & top - tack together. Quilt & bind 3 sides only

8. Lay the flap on top of the hole. Mark where the jagged Velcro should go on the underside of the flap to correspond to the soft bits on the quilt. Sew on the jagged Velcro bits.

9. Stitch the flap very firmly on to either side of the 'hole' at the bottom of the quilt above the binding line.

10. Bind ALL round the quilt, including across the bottom of the flap, using 1/2in binding to hold the flap very firmly in place.
